DIRECTIONS TO WARD POUND RIDGE STATE PARK

From Manhattan, Queens and Brooklyn: Triborough Bridge to I-87 (Major Deegan), to **Cross County to Hutchinson Parkway North**. Next Hutchinson changes to I-684 North towards Brewster. Take **I-684** up to **Exit 6** (Rt. 35) Take **Rt. 35 East** and go up to **Rt. 121 South**. Make right to Rt. 121 South, next the first quick left to **Reservation Rd.** Follow up to the Park Entry. Use attached sketch to **Shelter # 16 at Pell Hill Picnic Area**. Park your car there at the **parking lot** and walk 100 feet to Shelter 16.

From Danbury, CT: I-84 West to I-684 South. Take exit to Rt 35 East. *Follow as above.*

From New Jersey: Garden State Pkwy to I-287 East, take Tappan Zee Bridge and I-287 to I-684 North. *follow as above.*
